Our mission is to assure the world's readiness to respond to the next pandemic through transformative change in vaccine access and immunization policy, with a focus on low- and middle-income countries.

The Need for Change

- Vaccines remain a key tool for reducing disease burden and for responding to pandemics.
- Influenza vaccination programs are under-used, especially in low- and middle-income countries.
- Efforts to expand influenza and adult vaccination have been modestly effective.
- Unreliable demand prevents sustained production capacity.
- The COVID-19 pandemic vaccination program deployment challenges illustrate the difficulty of developing adult vaccination programs emergently.

Proposed Inter-pandemic Emphasis

- LMICs are determined to build capacity, expertise and to be self-sufficient.
- Leverage results from COVID-19 health system strengthening investments to ensure immunization programs readiness and sustainability.
- Accelerate access of seasonal influenza and COVID-19 vaccination programs as tools to grow adult vaccination programs and to bolster pandemic preparedness.
